Due to the corona virus, all future meetings of the NJDA will be held virtually including the House of Delegates meeting in November. Staff is still available to aid members with any concerns.

The BOT reviewed the strength that advocacy brings regarding our representation as a state (NJDA) and nationally (ADA). In this respect, donating to our PAC fund is crucial.

Mr. Meisel continues to argue on our behalf regarding facial injectables and the competence of dentists to perform these procedures on the entire face (not just the peri-oral region).

Important to note is that by mid-September, the State Board of Dentistry will have met and decided upon criteria for CE credits and what leniency will be allowed regarding virtual CE in regards to this unusual year of distancing.

Crucial too, will be a discussion and decision by the Board regarding what a reasonable and fair fee for PPE expenses are in dental offices during these unprecedented circumstances. At this time, states are disallowing health care providers to institute temporary PPE fees specific to Co-Vid. In fact, New York state is requiring that health care providers return collected fees to patients.

The next virtual meeting of the Board is Septmeber 16, 2020.
